We look forward to seeing you at the 2026 Kansas 4-H wheat expo!

The event is August 4, 2026 at the Butler County Community Building (206 N. Griffin; El Dorado, KS. Here's what you need to know before you go:

- Check-in for will begin at 9:00 a.m. Be sure to bring your exhibits and drop off in the appropriate exhibit area. You'll have time to network, begin the judging activity and/or Crops ID contest and enjoy a snack before instructions are given and we depart for tours.
- at 9:30, we'll begin dismissing for tours. The tours will be about 20 minutes from our location. Attendees will need to drive their own vehicles/carpool. Committee members will lead the way. Everyone will attend the same tours, but we'll split up into two groups and rotate.
- Join us back at the community Building at around 12:15pm for lunch. Youth participants will have time to wrap up their judging activity and crops ID.
- This event is generously funded through sponsorships. Participants will receive ribbons as well as premium money, which would not be possible without our donors. Blank thank you cards will be available and we ask that everyone complete at least one thank you. Please be mindful that a thank you to a sponsor should say more than, "Thank you for sponsoring the 4-H Wheat Expo."
